**Feedback:** With regards to the level of compliance by India to the decisions of the Commission, the Compliance Committee noted certain issues that required attention. These concerns were communicated to India by the Chair of the Commission in a letter dated 1<sup>st</sup> May, 2015.

- Has not provided all the mandatory information to IOTC Standard on the List of Authorized vessels 24 metres in length overall or more, provided GRT instead of GT, missing: Registration Number, Port of Registration, as required by Resolution 14/04.
- Has not provided all the mandatory information to IOTC Standard on the List of Authorized vessels < 24 metres, provided GRT instead of GT, missing: Registration Number, Port of Registration, as required by Resolution 14/04.
- Has not Adopted VMS for all vessels greater than 15 metres in length overall, as required by Resolution 06/03.
- Has not provided the mandatory VMS report on the progress and implementation, as required by Resolution 06/03.
- Has not reported Nominal catch to IOTC Standard for the longline fisheries, as required by Resolution 10/02.
- Has not reported Catch and effort to IOTC Standard for the coastal fisheries, as required by Resolution 10/02.
- Has not reported Catch and effort to IOTC Standard for the longline fisheries, as required by Resolution 10/02.
- Has not reported Size frequency for the coastal fisheries, as required by Resolution 10/02.
- Has not reported Size frequency for the longline fisheries, as required by Resolution 10/02.
- Has not reported Nominal catch on sharks to IOTC Standard as required by Resolution 05/05.

- Has not implemented the observer scheme for artisanal landing, as required by Resolution 11/04.
- Has not provided all the mandatory information on the Official authorisation to fish outside National Jurisdictions, as required by Resolution 14/04.
