**Feedback:** With regards to the level of compliance by the Republic of Korea to the decisions of the Commission, the Compliance Committee noted certain issues that required attention. These concerns were communicated to the Republic of Korea by the Chair of the Commission in a letter dated 1<sup>st</sup> May, 2015.
