### Meeting Venue:

The Protea Hotel by Marriott Cape Town Victoria Junction (VJ) is situated in Green Point. The V&A Waterfront which is one of the largest shopping malls in Cape Town that comprises of international retail stores, restaurants, leisure and entertainment, is about a 15 minute walk from the hotel. The VJ offers complimentary shuttles to and from the Waterfront from 19h00pm with the last shuttle to return to the hotel at 22h00pm. A concierge is available to arrange transfers to and from the hotel. In case of medical emergency an on call doctor/ dentist can be contacted by reception.

A block booking has been made for both WPB and WPEB meetings at discount rates of R1380 for a single room and R1775 for a double room, both inclusive of breakfast.
