Meeting Participation fund (for developing IOTC Contracting Parties Members only)

The participation of one representative from developing Members of the IOTC to scientific meetings may be supported through the IOTC Meeting Participation Fund (MPF). The applications for the IOTC MPF, must be received by the IOTC Secretariat (iotc-secretariat@fao.org) no later than 45 days in advance of the meeting. NOTE – this date will be strictly enforced.

Applications must include:

- i) an official nomination letter;
- ii) a detailed abstract of the scientific paper to be presented; and
- iii) the contact details of the nominee (with a copy of his/her passport).

Click here. Please be reminded that there is no provision in the IOTC Rules of Procedure (2014) for the IOTC Secretariat to consider late applications to the MPF.

Credentials are required for the Scientific Committee meeting participants

In accordance with Rule III of the IOTC Rules of Procedure (2014), official credentials are required in order to participate in the Scientific Committee meeting. Contracting Parties & Cooperating Non-contracting Parties (CPCs)

Each CPC is requested to provide a letter of credentials signed by the appropriate Authority indicating who will attend the meeting and in what capacity, no later than 15 days before the meeting to iotc-secretariat@fao.org and a hard copy at the commencement of the meeting.

Delegates wishing to attend the meeting as pre-approved IOTC Observers are also requested to submit a similar Letter of Credentials, no later than 15 days before the Session to iotc-secretariat@fao.org and a hard copy at the commencement of the meeting.
