Feedback to China on the level of implementation of IOTC Conservation and Management Measures identified by the CoC09 in 2012.

Feedback: With regards to the level of compliance by China to the decisions of the Commission, the Compliance Committee noted certain issues that required attention. These concerns were communicated to China by the Chair of the Commission in a letter dated 26th April, 2006.

The CoC ACKNOWLEDGED the important work that China has undertaken since CoC08 in addressing the concerns raised at that time, as well as the difficulties that China continues to face to fully implement a number of the CMMs adopted by the Commission, including the following:
• Resolution 06/03 (VMS): The CoC noted that China has adopted VMS since 2004. The CoC ACKNOWLEDGE the commitment of China to continue to strengthen its VMS and ENCOURAGED China to provide a summary of VMS records for the time-area closure according to Resolution 10/01).
• Resolution 11/04 (Regional Observer Scheme): Although the observer scheme for China commenced in 2002, there has been a limited number of observers placed on vessels, in particular in recent years (one in 2011). An observer report for 2010 was submitted to the Secretariat as required. China committed to continue to deploy observers on its active vessels.

Response: No response to the letter of the Chair of the Commission was provided by China.

Current issues on the level of implementation by China of IOTC Conservation and Management Measures identified for discussion in the CoC09 in 2012.

Having reviewed the 2013 Compliance Report for China, the Chair of the Compliance Committee has identified the following significant non-compliance issues for discussion.

• Has not provided size frequency data, as required by Res. 10/02.
• Has not transposed the ban on thresher sharks (Res. 12/09) into domestic legislation.
• Has not provided observer report, as required by Res. 11/04.
• Has not provided the mandatory report on comparison of export and import, as required by Res. 01/06.
