Feedback to Comoros on the level of implementation of IOTC Conservation and Management Measures identified by the CoC09 in 2012.

Feedback: With regards to the level of compliance by Comoros to the decisions of the Commission, the Compliance Committee noted certain issues that required attention. These concerns were communicated to Comoros by the Chair of the Commission in a letter dated 26th April, 2012.

Comoros has not submitted its Fleet Development Plan according to the requirements of the resolution, but expressed its commitment to conform to those requirements as soon as possible, |
