Feedback to India on the level of implementation of IOTC Conservation and Management Measures identified by the CoC09 in 2012.

Feedback: With regards to the level of compliance by India to the decisions of the Commission, the Compliance Committee noted certain issues that required attention. These concerns were communicated to India by the Chair of the Commission in a letter dated 26th April, 2012.

- Resolution 01/06 (Bigeye statistical document program): The CoC **ENCOURAGED** India to implement the Bigeye Tuna Statistical Document Program. India committed to investigate about Bigeye tuna export and report the result of the investigation inter-sessionally.
- Resolution 06/03 (VMS): The CoC noted the difficulties faced by India with regards to implementation of its VMS as a consequence of FMC being located in remote area and the difficulty to recruit operators for the FMC. The CoC **WELCOMED** the commitment of India to get its VMS fully operational during this year.
- Resolution 09/05 (Large-scale driftnets): The CoC noted that India has not provided information on the implementation of the ban of large-scale driftnet on the high seas in the IOTC Area and **ENCOURAGED** India to provide such information as early as possible.
- Resolution 10/02 (Mandatory statistical requirements): While noting the difficulties faced by India in meeting the data reporting requirements for its coastal fisheries, largely due to resource limitations and the difficulty to sample small-scale fisheries over an extensive coastline, the CoC **ENCOURAGED** India to continue its efforts to report data, in particular catch and effort, and size frequency data, for artisanal fisheries and longline fisheries.
- Resolution 11/04 (Regional Observer Scheme): The CoC noted the difficulties faced by India in implementing a national observer programme as required, largely due to the limited resources available and the lack of adequately trained observers. The CoC further took note of India's request for assistance from the IOTC in the implementation of the Regional Observer Scheme following IOTC standard.

Response: No response to the letter of the Chair of the Commission was provided by India.

<u>Current issues on the level of implementation by India of IOTC Conservation and</u> Management Measures identified for discussion in the CoC10 in 2013.

Having reviewed the 2013 Compliance Report for India, the Chair of the Compliance Committeehas identified the following significant non-compliance issues for discussion.

- Has not provided the mandatory report of vessels active in the IOTC Area during 2012, as required by Res. 10/08.
- Has not provided the mandatory VMS report on the progress and implementation, as required by Res. 06/03.
- Has not reported nominal catch and catch and effort data, as required by Resolution 10/02, for the coastal fisheries. Has not reported size frequency data for all the coastal and longline fisheries.
- Has not implemented an observer programme, as required by Res. 11/04.
