<u>Feedback to Maldives on the level of implementation of IOTC Conservation and</u> Management Measures identified by the CoC09 in 2012.

Feedback: With regards to the level of compliance by Maldives to the decisions of the Commission, the Compliance Committee noted certain issues that required attention. These concerns were communicated to Maldives by the Chair of the Commission in a letter dated 26 April 2012.

The CoC **ACKNOWLEDGED** the important work that Maldives had undertaken in addressing the concerns raised by CoC08 in 2011, as well as the difficulties that Maldives continues to face in fully implementing a number of the CMMs adopted by the Commission, including the following:

- Resolution 10/02 (Minimum reporting requirements): Noting the progress that Maldives
 has made over the past year in implementing and improving upon data collection and
 reporting systems, the CoC noted that Maldives is not fully compliant with the IOTC data
 reporting requirements, in particular catch and effort, and size frequency data. The CoC
 ENCOURAGED Maldives to make further improvements in data reporting to the IOTC
 standard during the coming year.
- Resolution 11/04 (Regional observer scheme): Noting that Maldives has commenced activities in order to implement an observer scheme in accordance with this Resolution, the CoC **ENCOURAGED** Maldives to continue to move towards implementation during the intersessional period.
- Resolution 10/11 (On port state measures to prevent, deter and eliminate illegal, unreported and unregulated fishing): Noting that Maldives has not provided the list of the designated ports, the name of the competent authority and the notification periods notice, the CoC **URGED** Maldives to report the information as soon as possible.
- Resolution 09/02 (Fleet Development Plan). Noting that Maldives has not reported its list of active vessels for 2006 tropical tunas to the Secretariat, the CoC **URGED** the Maldives to submit the required information as soon as possible.

Response: No response to the letter of the Chair of the Commission was provided by Maldives.

<u>Current issues on the level of implementation by Maldives of IOTC Conservation and</u> Management Measures identified for discussion in the CoC10 in 2013.

Having reviewed the 2013 Compliance Report for Maldives, the Chair of the Compliance Committee has identified the following significant non-compliance issues for discussion.

- Has not reported the list of vessels for Tropical Tuna during 2006, as required by Resolution 12/11.
- Has not implemented an observer programme as required by Re. 11/04.
- Has not provided the mandatory report on comparison of export and import and has not provided information on institution and personal authorised to validate statistical documents of Bigeye tuna, as required by Res. 01/06.
- Has not provided the mandatory VMS report on the progress and implementation, as required by Res. 06/03.
