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**Feedback to Mauritius on the level of implementation of IOTC Conservation and Management Measures identified by the CoC09 in 2012.**

**Feedback:** With regards to the level of compliance by Mauritius to the decisions of the Commission, the Compliance Committee noted certain issues that required attention. These concerns were communicated to Mauritius by the Chair of the Commission in a letter dated 26 April 2012.

The CoC <b>ACKNOWLEDGED</b> the important work that Mauritius had undertaken in addressing the concerns raised by CoC08 in 2011, as well as the difficulties that Mauritius continues to face in fully implementing a number of the CMMs adopted by the Commission, including the following:
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Resolutions 09/06, 10/06, 10/12 (Marine turtles, seabirds, thresher sharks): The CoC noted that Mauritius has not implemented the requirements of IOTC Conservation and Management Measures on marine turtles, seabirds and thresher sharks into domestic legislation as a binding requirement in a timely manner. The CoC <b>URGED</b> Mauritius to transpose those measures into its national legislation.</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Resolution 11/04 (Regional observer scheme): Noting that Mauritius has not implemented an observer scheme in accordance with this Resolution, but has trained fisheries observers, the CoC <b>URGED</b> Mauritius to implement the observer scheme as soon as possible.</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Resolution 10/02 (Minimum reporting requirements): Noting the progress that Mauritius has made over the past year in implementing and improving upon data collection and reporting systems, the CoC noted that Mauritius is not fully compliant with the IOTC data reporting requirements, in particular catch and effort, and size frequency data for artisanal fisheries and for longline fisheries has not been reported, or only partially reported. The CoC <b>URGED</b> Mauritius to make further improvements in data collection and reporting during the intersessional period.</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Resolution 09/02 (Fleet development plan). Noting that Mauritius has not reported origin and capacity of vessels in its FDP, the CoC <b>URGED</b> Mauritius to complete its FDP and to provide the requested information as soon as possible.</li></ul>

**Response:** Mauritius provided its response to the letter of the Chair of the Commission on 28<sup>th</sup> March, 2013.

**Current issues on the level of implementation by Mauritius of IOTC Conservation and Management Measures identified for discussion in the CoC10 in 2013.**

Having reviewed the 2013 Compliance Report for Mauritius, the Chair of the Compliance Committee has identified the following significant non-compliance issues for discussion.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Has not reported information on Access Agreement as required by Resolution 12/07.</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Has not implemented an observer programme as required by Re. 11/04.</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Has not reported size frequency data for the coastal fisheries as required by Res. 10/02.</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Has not provided the mandatory report on comparison of export and import, as required by Res. 01/06.</li></ul>
