**Feedback to Tanzania on the level of implementation of IOTC Conservation and Management Measures identified by the CoC09 in 2012.**

**Feedback:** With regards to the level of compliance by Tanzania to the decisions of the Commission, the Compliance Committee noted certain issues that required attention. These concerns were communicated to Tanzania by the Chair of the Commission in a letter dated 26 April 2012.

<p>The CoC EXPRESSED its disappointment that Tanzania was not present at the CoC09 meeting and agreed that its absence compromised the ability of the CoC to understand the compliance situation in Tanzania.</p> <p>The following non-compliance issues were identified in the 2012 compliance report:</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Resolution 10/02 (Minimum reporting requirements): While noting the progress that Tanzania has made over the past year in implementing and improving its data collection and reporting systems, the CoC noted that Tanzania is not meeting its obligations with the data reporting requirements, in particular nominal catch, catch and effort, size frequency data, and bycatch data for its domestic fisheries and the longline fishery. The CoC ENCOURAGED Tanzania to make further improvements in data collection and reporting during the intersessional period.</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Has not reported a list of active vessels for 2011 (Res. 10/08).</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Non-compliant with the IOTC data reporting requirements for the coastal fisheries and longline fisheries (nominal catch, catch and effort, size frequency, bycatch) (Res. 10/02).</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Has not implemented requirements of IOTC Conservation and Management Measures on marine turtles, seabirds and thresher sharks into domestic legislation as a binding requirement (Res. 09/06, 10/06, 10/12).</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Has not implemented an observer programme and sampling scheme as required by resolution 11/04.</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Has not reported a list of designated ports as required by Resolution 10/11.</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Given the difficulties faced by Tanzania to exercise effective control on some sectors of its fleet, the CoC WELCOMED the commitment by Tanzania to de-register the vessels that have been recently registered there.</li></ul>

**Response:** No response to the letter of the Chair of the Commission was provided by Tanzania.

**Current issues on the level of implementation by Tanzania of IOTC Conservation and Management Measures identified for discussion in the CoC10 in 2013.**

Having reviewed the 2013 Compliance Report for Tanzania, the Chair of the Compliance Committee has identified the following significant non-compliance issues for discussion.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Has not reported nominal catch, catch and effort, size frequency data, and bycatch data for coastal fisheries and the longline fishery as required by Resolution 10/02.</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Has not reported a list of active vessels for 2012 as required by Resolution 10/08.</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Has not implemented requirements of IOTC Conservation and Management Measures on seabirds, thresher sharks, large scale driftnets into domestic legislation as required by Resolutions 10/06, 12/09 and 12/12.</li></ul>
