Feedback to Iran on the level of implementation of IOTC Conservation and Management Measures identified by the CoC09 in 2012.

Feedback: With regards to the level of compliance by Iran to the decisions of the Commission, the Compliance Committee noted certain issues that required attention. These concerns were communicated to Iran by the Chair of the Commission in a letter dated 26th April, 2012.

<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Resolution 06/03 (VMS): Noting the difficulties faced by I.R. Iran in ensuring that VMS is implemented on all its vessels in accordance with this resolution, the CoC URGED I.R. Iran to continue its efforts to improve the situation for next year, extending the level of coverage of the system.
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Resolution 09/02 (Fleet development plans): Noting that Iran has not reported on the origin of vessels included in the Fleet Development Plan as required, the CoC URGED I.R. Iran to provide this information as soon as possible.
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Resolution 11/04 (Regional Observer Program): While noting the difficulties faced by I.R. Iran in meeting the minimum observer coverage levels on vessels under 24 m of length overall as required by this Resolution, the CoC ENCOURAGED I.R. Iran to continue its efforts to improve the situation for next year.

Response: No response to the letter of the Chair of the Commission was provided by Iran.

Current issues on the level of implementation by Iran of IOTC Conservation and Management Measures identified for discussion in the CoC10 in 2013.

Having reviewed the 2013 Compliance Report for Iran, the Chair of the Compliance Committee has identified the following significant non-compliance issues for discussion.

<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Only two per cent of vessels of 15m and above are monitored through a satellite-based VMS, as required by Res. 06/03.
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Has not reported catch and effort data for the coastal and surface fisheries, as required by Res. 10/02. Size frequency data only partially reported.
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Has not submitted observer report, as required by Res. 11/04. Observer coverage is less than 5%.
