Feedback to India on the level of implementation of IOTC Conservation and Management Measures identified by the CoC10 in 2013.

Feedback: With regards to the level of compliance by India to the decisions of the Commission, the Compliance Committee noted certain issues that required attention. These concerns were communicated to India by the Chair of the Commission in a letter dated 10th May, 2013.

• Resolution 01/06 (Bigeye statistical document program): The CoC ENCOURAGED India to implement the Bigeye Statistical Document Program.
• Resolution 12/09 (Thresher sharks): The CoC noted that India has difficulties on the implementation of the ban of thresher sharks in the IOTC Area and ENCOURAGED India to provide information as early as possible on the measures it has taken to transpose the resolution.
• Resolution 10/02 (Mandatory statistical requirements): While noting the difficulties faced by India in meeting the data reporting requirements for its coastal fisheries, largely due to resource limitations and the difficulty to sample small-scale fisheries over an extensive coastline and has not reported size frequency data for all the coastal and longline fisheries, the CoC ENCOURAGED India to continue its efforts to report data, in particular catch and effort, and size frequency data for artisanal fisheries and longline fisheries.
• Resolution 11/04 (Regional Observer Scheme): The CoC noted that India has not implemented an observer programme. The CoC URGED India to make further improvements in the intersessional period.
• Resolution 06/03 (VMS report on the progress and implementation): Noting that India has not provided the mandatory report on VMS, the CoC URGED India to provide the mandatory VMS report on the progress and implementation as required by the resolution.
• Response to the letter of feedback: Noting that India has not provided a response to the letter of feedback, the CoC ENCOURAGED India to provide a response to the letter of feedback of 2012.

Response: No response to the letter of the Chair of the Commission was provided by India.

Current issues on the level of implementation by India of IOTC Conservation and Management Measures identified for discussion in the CoC11 in 2014.

Having reviewed the 2014 Compliance Report for India, the Chair of the Compliance Committee has identified the following significant non-compliance issues for discussion.

• Has not provided its Report of Implementation, in accordance to Article X of the Agreement.
• Has not provided a response to the Letter of Feedback.
• Has not provided the mandatory report of vessels active in the IOTC Area during 2012 and 2013, as required by Res. 10/08.
• Has not provided the mandatory VMS report on the progress and implementation, as required by Res. 06/03.
• Has not reported catch and effort data, and size frequency information as required by Resolution 10/02.
• Has not reported catch data of sharks, as required by Res. 05/05.
• Has not implemented an observer programme, as required by Res. 11/04.
