Feedback to Iran on the level of implementation of IOTC Conservation and Management Measures identified by the CoC10 in 2013.

Feedback: With regards to the level of compliance by Iran to the decisions of the Commission, the Compliance Committee noted certain issues that required attention. These concerns were communicated to Iran by the Chair of the Commission in a letter dated 10th May, 2013.

<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Resolution 10/02 (Minimum reporting requirements): While noting the progress that Iran has made over the past year in implementing and improving upon data collection and reporting systems, the CoC noted that Iran has not reported catch and effort data for the coastal and surface fisheries, and size frequency data was only partially reported. The CoC ENCOURAGED I.R. Iran to make further improvements in data collection and reporting during the intersessional period.
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Resolution 06/03 (VMS): Noting the difficulties faced by I.R. Iran in ensuring that VMS is implemented on its vessels and noting that only two per cent of vessels of 15m and above are monitored through a satellite-based VMS, the CoC URGED I.R. Iran to continue its efforts to improve the situation for next year by extending the level of coverage of the system.
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Resolution 11/04 (Regional Observer Scheme): While noting the difficulties faced by I.R. Iran in meeting the minimum observer coverage levels and submitting the observer report as required by this resolution, the CoC ENCOURAGED I.R. Iran to continue its efforts to improve the situation for next year
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Response to the letter of feedback: Noting that I.R. Iran has not provided a response to the letter of feedback, the CoC ENCOURAGED I.R. Iran to provide a response to the letter of feedback of 2012.

Response: No response to the letter of the Chair of the Commission was provided by Iran.

Current issues on the level of implementation by Iran of IOTC Conservation and Management Measures identified for discussion in the CoC11 in 2014.

Having reviewed the 2014 Compliance Report for Iran, the Chair of the Compliance Committee has identified the following significant non-compliance issues for discussion.

<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Has not provided a response to the feedback letter, as required by the Commission.
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Has not submitted the official authorisation to fish outside national jurisdictions, as required by Res. 13/02.
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Has not fully implemented the satellite-based VMS (660 vessels of 15m and above are monitored with offline VMS), as required by Res. 06/03.
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Has not implemented the regional observer scheme, as required by Res. 11/04.
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Has not provided information on purse seiners to carry dip nets, as required by Resolution 12/04.
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Has not submitted the report on import, landing, transshipment of tuna and tuna-like fish products in ports, as required by Res. 10/10.
