Feedback to Japan on the level of implementation of IOTC Conservation and Management Measures identified by the CoC10 in 2013.

Feedback: With regards to the level of compliance by Japan to the decisions of the Commission, the Compliance Committee noted certain issues that required attention. These concerns were communicated to Japan by the Chair of the Commission in a letter dated 10 May 2013.

- Resolution 10/02 (Minimum reporting requirements): While noting the progress that Japan has made over the past year in implementing and improving upon data collection and reporting systems, the CoC noted that Japan has reported size frequency data but not at the IOTC Standard. The CoC **ENCOURAGED** Japan to make further improvements in data collection and reporting during the intersessional period.

Response: Japan provided its response to the letter of the Chair of the Commission on 31st March, 2014.

Current issues on the level of implementation by Japan of IOTC Conservation and Management Measures identified for discussion in the CoC11 in 2014.

Having reviewed the 2014 Compliance Report for Japan, the Chair of the Compliance Committee has identified the following significant non-compliance issues for discussion.

- Has not provided size data regarding sharks, as required by Res. 05/05.
- Has not provided the mandatory report on import, landing, transshipment of tuna and tuna-like fish products in ports size data regarding sharks, as required by Res. 10/10.
- Has not provided the responses to the possible infraction within the deadline, as required by Res. 12/05.
