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**Feedback to Mozambique on the level of implementation of IOTC Conservation and Management Measures identified by the CoC10 in 2013.**

**Feedback:** With regards to the level of compliance by Mozambique to the decisions of the Commission, the Compliance Committee noted certain issues that required attention. These concerns were communicated to Mozambique by the Chair of the Commission in a letter dated 10<sup>th</sup> May 2013.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Resolution 10/02 (Minimum reporting requirements): Noting Mozambique has not reported catch and effort and size frequency data to the standard required by this resolution, the CoC <b>ENCOURAGED</b> Mozambique to make further improvements in data collection and report during the intersessional period.</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Resolution 11/04 (Regional Observer Scheme): Noting that Mozambique has no sampling scheme for the artisanal fishery, the CoC <b>URGED</b> Mozambique to continue its implementation of the observer programme and report on its progress as soon as possible.</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Resolution 07/02 (Record of authorised vessels): Noting that Mozambique has not provided information on GT for vessel above 24 meters. The CoC <b>ENCOURAGED</b> Mozambique to provide as soon as possible the required information.</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Resolution 01/06 (Statistical Document programme). Noting that Mozambique has not provided the mandatory report on comparison of export and import, the CoC <b>URGED</b> the Mozambique to submit the required information as soon as possible.</li></ul>

**Response:** Mozambique provided its response to the letter of the Chair of the Commission on 10<sup>th</sup> June 2013.

**Current issues on the level of implementation by Mozambique of IOTC Conservation and Management Measures identified for discussion in the CoC11 in 2014.**

Having reviewed the 2014 Compliance Report for Mozambique, the Chair of the Compliance Committee has identified the following significant non-compliance issues for discussion.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Has not transposed the prohibition on thresher sharks, as required by Resolution, 12/09.</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Has not transposed the prohibition on oceanic whitetip sharks, as required by Resolutions, 13/06.</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Has not transposed the provision to carry line cutters and de-hookers on board, as required by Resolution, 12/04.</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Has not transposed the seabirds mitigation measures south of 25°S into national legislation, as required by Resolution 10/06.</li></ul>
