Feedback to Korea on the level of implementation of IOTC Conservation and Management Measures identified by the CoC10 in 2013.

Feedback: With regards to the level of compliance by Korea to the decisions of the Commission, the Compliance Committee noted certain issues that required attention. These concerns were communicated to Korea by the Chair of the Commission in a letter dated 10th May 2013.

- Report of Implementation: Noting that Korea has provided its Report of Implementation after the deadline, the CoC **ENCOURAGED** Korea to provide its report of implementation according to the deadline.
- Resolution 10/02 (Minimum reporting requirements): The CoC **NOTED** that Korea has not provided size frequency data. The CoC **ENCOURAGED** Korea to make further improvements in data collection and reporting during the intersessional period.

Response: Korea provided its response to the letter of the Chair of the Commission on 02 April 2014.

<u>Current issues on the level of implementation by Korea of IOTC Conservation and Management Measures identified for discussion in the CoC11 in 2014.</u>

Having reviewed the 2014 Compliance Report for Korea, the Chair of the Compliance Committee has identified the following significant non-compliance issues for discussion.

- Has not reported size frequency data for surface fisheries, as required by Res. 10/02.
- Has not provided the mandatory report on import, landing, transhipment of tuna and tuna-like fish products in ports, as required by Res. 10/10.
