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**Feedback to Madagascar on the level of implementation of IOTC Conservation and Management Measures identified by the CoC10 in 2013.**

**Feedback:** With regards to the level of compliance by Madagascar to the decisions of the Commission, the Compliance Committee noted certain issues that required attention. These concerns were communicated to Madagascar by the Chair of the Commission in a letter dated 10<sup>th</sup> May, 2013.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Resolution 01/02 (Management Standards): Noting that Madagascar has not provided information on the management standards of its fleet, the CoC <b>ENCOURAGED</b> Madagascar to report the information during the intersessional period.</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Resolution 10/11 (On port state measures to prevent, deter and eliminate illegal, unreported and unregulated fishing): Noting that Madagascar has not provided the list of the designated ports, the name of the competent authority and the notification periods notice, the CoC <b>URGED</b> Madagascar to report the information as early as possible.</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Resolution 11/04 (Regional Observer Scheme): Noting that Madagascar has not provided information on the implementation of the observer scheme in its domestic fisheries in accordance with the requirements of the resolution, the CoC <b>ENCOURAGED</b> Madagascar to report the relevant information as early as possible.</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Resolution 06/03 (VMS report on the progress and implementation): Noting that Madagascar has not provided the mandatory report on VMS, the CoC <b>URGED</b> Madagascar to provide the mandatory VMS report on the progress and implementation as required by this resolution.</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Resolution 12/11 (Ban large scale driftnet): Noting that Madagascar has a legislation waiting for adoption on the ban on large scale driftnet, the CoC <b>URGED</b> Madagascar to provide the draft legislation as soon as possible and report on the date of adoption of the legislation.</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Resolution 12/09 (Ban large scale driftnet): Noting that Madagascar has not transposed the ban on thresher sharks into domestic legislation, the CoC <b>URGED</b> Madagascar to transpose this provision into the domestic legislation.</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Resolution 10/02 (Minimum reporting requirements): The CoC <b>NOTED</b> that Madagascar has not reported nominal catch, catch &amp; effort and size frequency for the coastal fisheries. The CoC <b>ENCOURAGED</b> Madagascar to make further improvements in data collection and reporting during the intersessional period.</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Response to the letter of feedback: Noting that Madagascar has not provided a response to the letter of feedback, the CoC <b>ENCOURAGED</b> Madagascar to provide a response to the letter of feedback of 2012.</li></ul>

**Feedback:** No response to the letter of the Chair of the Commission was provided by Madagascar.

**Current issues on the level of implementation by Madagascar of IOTC Conservation and Management Measures identified for discussion in the CoC11 in 2014.**

Having reviewed the 2014 Compliance Report for Madagascar, the Chair of the Compliance Committee has identified the following significant non-compliance issues for discussion.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Has not reported catch &amp; effort for foreign fishing vessels, as required by Res. 10/02.</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Has not provided the annual report of the BET Statistical Document Programme, as required by Res. 01/06</li></ul>
