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**Feedback to Maldives on the level of implementation of IOTC Conservation and Management Measures identified by the CoC10 in 2013.**

**Feedback:** With regards to the level of compliance by Maldives to the decisions of the Commission, the Compliance Committee noted certain issues that required attention. These concerns were communicated to Maldives by the Chair of the Commission in a letter dated 10<sup>th</sup> May 2013.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Resolution 11/04 (Regional Observer Scheme): Noting that Maldives has commenced activities in order to implement an observer scheme in accordance with this Resolution, the CoC <b>ENCOURAGED</b> Maldives to continue to move towards implementation during the intersessional period.</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Resolution 12/11 (Baseline capacities). Noting that Maldives has not reported its list of active vessels for 2006 for tropical tunas to the Secretariat, the CoC <b>URGED</b> the Maldives to submit the required information as soon as possible.</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Resolution 01/06 (Statistical Document programme). Noting that Maldives has not provided the mandatory report on comparison of export and import and has not provided information on institution and personal authorised to validate statistical documents of Bigeye tuna, the CoC <b>URGED</b> the Maldives to submit the required information as soon as possible.</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Resolution 06/03 (VMS report on the progress and implementation): Noting that Maldives has not provided the mandatory report on VMS, the CoC <b>URGED</b> Maldives to provide the mandatory VMS report on the progress and implementation.</li></ul>

**Response:** No response to the letter of the Chair of the Commission was provided by Maldives.

**Current issues on the level of implementation by Maldives of IOTC Conservation and Management Measures identified for discussion in the CoC11 in 2014.**

Having reviewed the 2014 Compliance Report for Maldives, the Chair of the Compliance Committee has identified the following significant non-compliance issues for discussion.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Has not provided data on sharks, as required by Res 05/05.</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Has not implemented the observer scheme for vessel above 24m LOA and artisanal landing, and has not provided observer reports, as required by Resolution 11/04.</li></ul>
