**Feedback to Oman on the level of implementation of IOTC Conservation and Management Measures identified by the CoC10 in 2013.**

**Feedback:** With regards to the level of compliance by Oman to the decisions of the Commission, the Compliance Committee noted certain issues that required attention. These concerns were communicated to Oman by the Chair of the Commission in a letter dated 10<sup>th</sup> May 2013.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Resolution 10/02 (Minimum reporting requirements): Noting the progress that Oman has made over the past year in implementing and improving upon data collection and reporting systems, the CoC noted that Oman has not reported size frequency data for the coastal and longline fisheries. The CoC <b>URGED</b> Oman to report size frequency data for the coastal and longline fisheries.</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Resolution 10/08 (list of active vessels): Noting that Oman has not reported its list of active vessels for 2012, the CoC <b>URGED</b> Oman to provide the information as soon as possible.</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Resolution 10/11 and 05/03 (On port State measures to prevent, deter and eliminate illegal, unreported and unregulated fishing): Noting that Oman has not provided the list of the designated ports, the name of the competent authority, the notification periods notice and the inspection reports, and the information on port inspection scheme as required by Res. 05/03 and 10/11, the CoC <b>URGED</b> Oman to report the information as soon as possible..</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Resolution 12/05 (Regional Observer Programme): Noting that Oman has not provided the mandatory report on transshipments carried out at sea, has not provided the mandatory report on transshipments in port and has not provided its feedback on all observer reports which highlight possible infractions, the CoC <b>NOTED</b> Oman's commitment to report the information as soon as possible.</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Resolution 06/03 (VMS report on the progress and implementation): Noting that Oman has not provided the mandatory report on VMS, the CoC <b>URGED</b> Oman to provide the mandatory VMS report on the progress and implementation.</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Response to the letter of feedback: Noting that Oman has not provided a response to the letter of feedback, the CoC <b>ENCOURAGED</b> Oman to provide a response to the letter of feedback of 2012.</li></ul>

**Response:** The response to the letter of the Chair of the Commission was provided by Oman on 23<sup>rd</sup> July 2013.

**Current issues on the level of implementation by Oman of IOTC Conservation and Management Measures identified for discussion in the CoC11 in 2014.**

Having reviewed the 2014 Compliance Report for Oman, the Chair of the Compliance Committee has identified the following significant non-compliance issues for discussion.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Has not provided the official authorisation to fish outside National Jurisdictions, as required by Resolution 13/02.</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Has not implemented the legal and administrative measures to implement the area Closure for longliners, as required by Resolution 12/13.</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Has not implemented the marking of fishing gears, as required by Resolution 13/02.</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Has not implemented an observer programme as required by Resolution 11/04.</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Has not reported size frequency data for the coastal and longline fisheries, as required by Resolution 10/02.</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Has not reported nominal catch, catch &amp; effort and size frequency data for the surface fisheries, as required by Resolution 10/02.</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Has not provided sea turtles report as required by Resolution 12/04.</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Has not provided the transshipment in port report as required by Resolution 12/05.</li></ul>
