## <u>Feedback to Philippines on the level of implementation of IOTC Conservation and Management Measures identified by the CoC10 in 2013.</u>

**Feedback:** With regards to the level of compliance by Philippines to the decisions of the Commission, the Compliance Committee noted certain issues that required attention. These concerns were communicated to Philippines by the Chair of the Commission in a letter dated 10<sup>th</sup> May 2013.

- Resolution 12/11 (Thresher sharks): Noting that Philippines has not incorporated the provisions of IOTC Conservation and Management Measures on thresher sharks into domestic legislation, the CoC **URGED** Philippines to transpose those measures into domestic legislation as early as possible.
- Resolution 11/04 (Regional Observer Scheme): Noting the difficulties faced by Philippines in implementing a regional observer scheme as required by this resolution, the CoC **URGED** Philippines to make further improvements in the intersessional period.
- Resolution 12/05 (Regional Observer Programme): Noting that Philippines has not provided the mandatory report on transhipments carried out at sea, the CoC **URGED** Philippines to report the information as soon as possible.
- Resolution 06/03 (VMS report on the progress and implementation): Noting that Philippines has not provided the mandatory report on VMS, the CoC **URGED** Philippines to provide the mandatory VMS report on the progress and implementation as early as possible.
- Resolution 01/06 (Statistical Document programme). Noting that Philippines has not provided the mandatory report on comparison of export and import, the CoC **URGED** the Philippines to submit the required information as soon as possible.
- Response to the letter of feedback: Noting that Philippines has not provided a response to the letter of feedback, the CoC URGED Philippines to provide a response to the letter of feedback of 2012.

**Response:** No response to the letter of the Chair of the Commission was provided by Philippines.

## <u>Current issues on the level of implementation by Philippines of IOTC Conservation and</u> Management Measures identified for discussion in the CoC11 in 2014.

Having reviewed the 2014 Compliance Report for Philippines, the Chair of the Compliance Committee has identified the following significant non-compliance issues for discussion.

- Has not provided a response to the letter of feedback as requested by the Commission.
- Has not transposed the ban on large scale driftnet into domestic legislation, as required by Resolution 12/11.
- Has not transposed the Prohibition on thresher sharks of all the species of the family Alopiidae into domestic legislation, as required by Resolution 12/09.
- Has not transposed the Prohibition on oceanic whitetip sharks (Carcharhinus longimanus) into domestic legislation, as required by Resolution. 13/06.
- Has not transposed the provision for longliners to carry line cutters and de-hookers on board (Longliners), as required by Resolution 12/04.
- Has not implemented an observer programme, as required by Res. 11/04.
- Has not implemented the legal and administrative measures to implement the area Closure for longliners as required by Resolution 12/13.
