<u>Feedback to the European Union on the level of implementation of IOTC Conservation</u> and Management Measures identified by the CoC11 in 2014.

Feedback: With regards to the level of compliance by the European Union to the decisions of the Commission, the Compliance Committee noted certain issues that required attention. These concerns were communicated to the European Union by the Chair of the Commission in a letter dated 5th June, 2014.

- Has not fully reported catch and effort and size frequency data, as required by Resolution 10/02, for some segments of its fleets.
- Has not provided inspection report and information on 5% inspection of LAN or TRX and denial of entry into port, as required by Res. 10/11.

Response: The response to the letter of the Chair of the Commission was provided by the European Union on 10 July 2014.
