Feedback: With regards to the level of compliance by I. R. Iran to the decisions of the Commission, the Compliance Committee noted certain issues that required attention. These concerns were communicated to I. R. Iran by the Chair of the Commission in a letter dated 5th June, 2014.

• Has not fully implemented the satellite-based VMS (660 vessels of 15m and above are monitored with offline VMS), as required by Res. 06/03.
• Has not implemented the regional observer scheme, as required by Res. 11/04.
• Has not provided information on purse seiners to carry dip nets, as required by Resolution 12/04.
• Has not submitted the report on import, landing, transshipment of tuna and tuna-like fish products in ports, as required by Res. 10/10.
