## <u>Feedback to the Republic of Korea on the level of implementation of IOTC Conservation</u> <u>and Management Measures identified by the CoC11 in 2014.</u>

**Feedback:** With regards to the level of compliance by the Republic of Korea\_to the decisions of the Commission, the Compliance Committee noted certain issues that required attention. These concerns were communicated to the Republic of Korea\_by the Chair of the Commission in a letter dated 5<sup>th</sup> June, 2014.

- Has not reported size frequency data for surface fisheries, as required by Res. 10/02.
- Has not provided the mandatory report on import, landing, transhipment of tuna and tuna-like fish products in ports, as required by Res. 10/10.

**Response:** The response to the letter of the Chair of the Commission was provided by the Republic of Korea\_on 18 March 2015.
