## <u>Feedback to Maldives on the level of implementation of IOTC Conservation and</u> Management Measures identified by the CoC11 in 2014.

**Feedback:** With regards to the level of compliance by Maldives to the decisions of the Commission, the Compliance Committee noted certain issues that required attention. These concerns were communicated to Maldives by the Chair of the Commission in a letter dated 5<sup>th</sup> June, 2014.

- Has not provided a response to the letter of feedback, as required by S17.
- Has not reported the list of vessels for Tropical Tuna during 2006, as required by Resolution 12/11.
- Has not provided data on length frequency for coastal, surface and longline fisheries, as required by Resolution 10/02.
- Has not provided data on sharks, as required by Res 05/05.
- Has not implemented the observer scheme for vessel above 24m LOA and artisanal landing, and has not provided observer reports, as required by Resolution 11/04.

**Response:** The response to the letter of the Chair of the Commission was provided by Maldives on 21 August 2014.
