Feedback to Mauritius on the level of implementation of IOTC Conservation and Management Measures identified by the CoC11 in 2014.

Feedback: With regards to the level of compliance by Mauritius to the decisions of the Commission, the Compliance Committee noted certain issues that required attention. These concerns were communicated to Mauritius by the Chair of the Commission in a letter dated 5th June, 2014.

• Has not implemented the legal and administrative measures to implement the area Closure, as required by Resolution 12/13.
• Has not reported size frequency data for the coastal fisheries as required by Resolution 10/02.
• Has not reported catch & effort of foreign vessels fishing in EEZ, Surface fisheries, as required by Res. 10/02.
• Has not provided the report of transshipments in ports of flagged vessels, as required by Resolution 12/05.
• Has not provided the report of landing of foreign vessels in national port, as required by Resolution 05/03.
• Has not inspected at least 5% of landing or transshipment, as required by Resolution 10/11.
