<u>Feedback to Korea on the level of implementation of IOTC Conservation and</u> <u>Management Measures identified by the CoC12 in 2015.</u>

Feedback: With regards to the level of compliance by the Republic of Korea to the decisions of the Commission, the Compliance Committee noted certain issues that required attention. These concerns were communicated to the Republic of Korea by the Chair of the Commission in a letter dated 1st May, 2015.

- Has not reported size frequency for surface fisheries to IOTC Standard (Less than one fish per metric ton of catch per species), as required by Resolution 10/02.
- Has not reported FADs set by type, as required by Resolution 10/02.

Response: The response to the letter of the Chair of the Commission was provided by the Republic of Korea on 02 May 2016.
