North Pacific Fisheries Commission (NPFC)

- Intent to bridge the gap in RFMO coverage for non-highly migratory species for the North Pacific Ocean
- **History:** Discussions from 2006 to NPFC Coming into force on 19 July 2015.
- **Members:** Canada, China, Japan, the Republic of Korea, the Russian Federation, Chinese Taipei, the United States of America, and Vanuatu
- **Objective:** to ensure the long-term conservation and sustainable use of the fisheries resources in the Convention Area while protecting the marine ecosystems of the North Pacific Ocean in which these resources occur.

 - **Registration System** - through the webpage; moving to Member Direct entry to save entry time, less errors, member responsibility for accuracy, Secretariat oversight and quality control

Let's get started

- Regulatory authority – CMM 2016-01 – Fishing Vessel Registry & Interim Register for non-Member Carriers – data requirements in the Annex:

a) Name* of fishing vessel, vessel status* (member/non-member), flag*, authorizing Member*, registration number*, previous names and port of registry;

b) IMO number (if eligible & by 1 Jan 2018);

c) Name* and address of owner* or owners;

d) Name* and citizenship of master;

e) Previous flag (if any);

f) International Radio Call Sign*;

g) Vessel communication types and numbers

h) Side view color photograph of vessel*

i) Where (country*, port) and when built;

j) Type of vessel* (ISSCFV);

k) Normal crew complement;

l) Type of fishing method (ISSCFG);

m) Length* (LOA/LBP*), (M/ft*);

n) Depth, deck/waterline, (M/ft)

o) Beam*, extreme beam/waterline*, M/ft*;

p) Tonnage* GRT/GT*;

q) Power of main engine HP/Kw;

r) Authorization to fish granted by the flag State, type or method main target species dates*;

s) Fish hold capacity, in cubic meters;

t) Freezer type and capacity, including unit of measurement.

* Mandatory Requirements for System Acceptance

NEW VESSEL

1. UNIQUE ID FOR EACH MEMBER – IN THIS CASE SET AS npfc AS 'PRESENTATION' VESSEL REGISTRY MANAGER FOR CANADA
2. Entering new vessel Theodore (vessel type = longliner; gear = set longlines)
3. Checking ISSCFV and ISSCFG for vessel and gear types
