ENTRY INTO EFFECT OF THE CONSERVATION AND MANAGEMENT MEASURES ADOPTED AT THE 23RD SESSION OF THE IOTC

The objection process for Resolution 19/01 *On an interim plan for rebuilding the Indian Ocean yellowfin tuna stock in the IOTC Area of competence* (as notified in IOTC Circular 2019-35 – <u>click here</u>) has concluded. Therefore, in accordance with Article IX of the IOTC Agreement, Resolution 19/01 came into force on 28 December 2019.

Resolution 18/01 On an Interim Plan for Rebuilding the Indian Ocean Yellowfin Tuna Stock in the IOTC Area of Competence remains binding for India.
