



LANDINGS BY FOREIGN VESSELS IN THE PORTS OF CPCs

PREPARED BY IOTC SECRETARIAT

This document summarises the information received in accordance with IOTC Resolution 05/03 Relating to the establishment of an IOTC programme of inspection in port.

Submission of lists of foreign fishing vessels and their landings for 2007

Paragraph 8. Each CPC shall submit electronically to the Secretary by 1 July of each year, the list of foreign fishing vessels which have landed in their ports tuna and tuna like species caught in the IOTC area in the preceding year. This information shall detail the catch composition by weight and species landed

Information on the status of reporting relating to IOTC Resolution 05/03 for 2007 is given in Table 1.

For 2007, the Secretariat received information from four CPCs (Madagascar, Mauritius, Seychelles and South Africa). All information, except that from Mauritius, submitted under the requirements of IOTC Resolution 05/03 was processed by the Secretariat. The Secretariat has requested additional information from Mauritius before the information can be processed.

Table 1: Reports by CPCs on the number and gear type of foreign fishing vessels which have landed tuna and tuna like species caught in the IOTC area during 2007 (IOTC Resolution 05/03). A blank square indicates that no data was received and n/a = not applicable (i.e. calls of foreign vessels operating in the Indian Ocean to ports in these countries are unlikely to occur).
