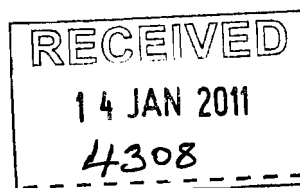

REPORT : VESSELS PRESUMED TO HAVE CARRIED OUT ILLEGAL, UNREGULATED AND UNREPORTED (IUU) FISHING IN THE IOTC AREA AS PER RESOLUTION 09/03

DATE: Tuesday, 16 November 2010

SUMMARY: On the 12th January 2010 Iranian flagged fishing vessel AI-FAHAD was reported by local fishermen to be fishing in the Seychelles waters and was then apprehended by the Seychelles coastguard on the 13th January 2010.

The investigation also proved that the vessel had also fished on the high seas within the IOTC conventional area in contravention of IOTC Resolution 07/02, plus the use of drift net that is an illegal gear within the IOTC conventional area.

The case was brought to the supreme court of Seychelles. After several court hearings the vessel owner requested for an out of court settlement and the case was then compounded between the Seychelles Government and master and owner of the vessel.

In accordance to resolution 09/03 the Seychelles Fishing Authority is satisfied that there is sufficient evidence that violates management measure adopted by IOTC to classify the vessel as IUU.

In addition to the above the master of the vessel has admitted to fishing in the jurisdiction of Seychelles and during the month of January 2010 without a foreign fishing vessel licence, contrary to section 7 or 17 of the Fisheries Act (cap82)

To that effect it is recommended that the report be circulated to all members of the IOTC for consideration of possible action and brought to the attention of the Compliance Committee for consideration of possible action.

SUMMARY:

SUMMARY: On the 12th January 2010 Iranian flagged fishing vessel AI-NAVEED was reported by local fishermen to be fishing in the Seychelles waters and was then apprehended by the Seychelles coastguard on the 13th January 2010. The investigation also proved that the vessel had also fished on the high seas within the IOTC conventional area in contravention of IOTC Resolution 07/02, plus the use of drift net that is an illegal gear within the IOTC conventional area.

The case was brought to the supreme court of Seychelles. After several court hearings the vessel owner requested for an out of court settlement and the case was then compounded between the Seychelles Government and master and owner of the vessel.

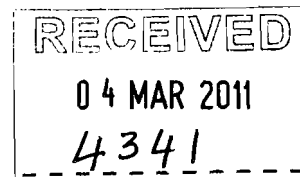

DATE: Friday, 25 February 2011

SUMMARY: On the 15th January 2010 Iranian flagged fishing vessel Al-ASSAD was reported by local fishermen to be fishing in the Seychelles waters and was then apprehended by the Seychelles coastguard on the Same day.
The investigation also proved that the vessel had also fished within the IOTC conventional area in contravention of IOTC Resolution 07/02, plus the use of drift net that is an illegal gear within the IOTC conventional area.

The case was brought to the Supreme Court of Seychelles. After several court hearings a ruling was made on the 1st February 2011. The vessel owner and master of the vessel were both found guilty for illegal fishing, whereby the illegal gear was forfeited to the SFA and a fine of SCR 400,000 to be paid within six week. Failure to comply to the condition of payment will lead to the forfeit ureof the vessel.

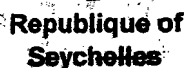



AFFIDAVIT IN SUPPORT

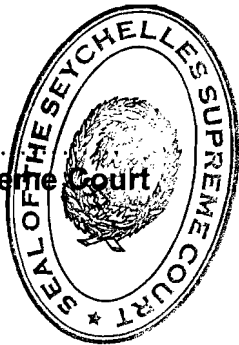
I, Sonny Naiken, an enforcement officer of the Seychelles Fishing Authority make oath and state as follows:
