



## REPORT ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF A LIMITATION OF FISHING CAPACITY OF CONTRACTING PARTIES AND COOPERATING NON-CONTRACTING PARTIES

**Prepared by IOTC Secretariat** 

This document summarises the information available to the Secretariat in accordance with IOTC Resolution 09/02 *On the implementation of a limitation of fishing capacity of Contracting Parties and Cooperating non-Contracting Parties*.

Paragraph 1. Contracting Parties and Cooperating non-Contracting Parties (CPCs) shall notify to the IOTC Secretariat, by 31 December 2009, the lists of vessels, by gear type, of 24 meters overall length and over, and under 24 meters if they fished outside their EEZs, and corresponding overall capacity in GT, which have actively fished in accordance with the provision of IOTC Resolution 07/04:

- for tropical tunas during the year 2006
- for swordfish and albacore during the year 2007

Tables 1 and 2 indicate the baseline limits on fishing capacity based on the tonnage and numbers of vessels declared as active in 2006 (for tropical tunas) and 2007 (for swordfish and albacore), plus vessels added to the reference tonnage from fleet development plans submitted by CPCs. For those CPCs that have not submitted the reports of their verified list of active vessels, in accordance to paragraph 1 of Resolution 09/02, the Secretariat has used the reference capacity reported under Resolution 07/04 for 2006 and 2007.

Paragraph 6. CPCs which had the objective of developing their fleets following the provisions of IOTC Resolution 03/01, through the introduction to the IOTC of a fleet development plan, shall confirm, by 31 December 2009, inter alia, the type, size, gear and origin of the vessels included in the Fleet Development Plans and the programming (precise calendar for the forthcoming 10 years) of their introduction into the fisheries.

Since the 14<sup>th</sup> Session of the Commission, revised Fleet Development Plans have been received from Belize, France (OT), Iran, Malaysia, Mauritius, Seychelles, and Thailand. New Fleet Development Plans have been received from India and Sri Lanka. Comoros and Tanzania have informed the Secretariat that they intend to submit their fleet development plans as soon as these are finalised. A compendium of the Fleet Development Plans is found in IOTC-2011-S15-CoC52 Add1.
