### VACANCY FOR A COMPLIANCE OFFICER AT THE IOTC SECRETARIAT

The IOTC is seeking qualified applicants for the position of Compliance Officer. The position is graded P3 and the key functions include:

- Providing support to the Secretariat's collection and analysis of information pertaining to the activities of parties in compliance with IOTC conservation and management measures.
- Supporting regional workshops and in-country compliance-related capacity building activities.
- Supporting the maintenance of the IOTC's Record of Authorized Vessels; Record of Active Vessels, List of IUU Vessels; and other compliance databases.
- Providing support to parties in the implementation of MCS measures adopted by the Commission, including those on port State measures and the regional observer programme.
