CONCERNING THE SUBMISSION OF THE STANDARD QUESTIONNAIRE ON COMPLIANCE WITH IOTC RESOLUTIONS

In accordance with Appendix V, paragraph 4.1 (ii) of the IOTC Rules of Procedure (2014), (Compliance Committee – Terms of Reference and Rules of Procedure), I would like to invite CPCs to review the responses to the IOTC Compliance Questionnaire, which have been published on the meeting page of the Compliance Committee 19. I would further like to invite CPCs to provide their comments and possible questions on these responses. To allow the Chairperson of the Compliance Committee and the IOTC Secretariat to identify and report on non-compliance issues, at the next Compliance Committee meeting, please provide your feedback no later than 28 March 2022.

To date, only 23 of 31 CPCs have submitted their completed Compliance Questionnaire. These are: Australia, Bangladesh, China, European Union, France (TOM), Indonesia, I.R. Iran, Japan, Kenya, Republic of Korea, Madagascar, Malaysia, Maldives, Mauritius, Mozambique, Oman, Philippines, Seychelles, Sri Lanka, South Africa, Tanzania, Thailand, United Kingdom.
