1. Has not provided size frequency at least 1 fish per tonne as required by Resolution 15/02

Size frequency data were provided to the IOTC but Mauritius did not meet the requirement of 1 fish per ton being given that the purse seiners unload most of its catch in Seychelles.

2. Has not reported size frequency for all species for longline fisheries as required by Resolution 15/02

Samples for size frequency could not be obtained for all the species for the longliners which were operating outside the EEZ and were based in a foreign port.

- 3. Has not provided catch &effort data for sharks as required by Resolution 17/05.
- 4. Has not provided size frequency data for sharks as required by Resolution 17/05.

With regard to 3 and 4, it is to be noted that no species of shark was present in the catch reported by the Mauritius flagged purse seiners. The nil catch for shark has been confirmed with the operators.

5. No LAN/TRX monitoring forms received as required by Resolution 16/11.

Remedial action was taken. Officers have been requested to take the necessary measures to cover at least 5% inspection on the total landing and transshipment activities in port and to ensure that all inspection forms are submitted in order to fulfill the requirement of Resolution 16/11.

6. Has not provided zero catch data as required by Resolution 18/07

The form was submitted by email on 30.06.2020 in a fourth batch of documents. (see screenshot below)

7. Has not fully reported observer coverage in artisanal fisheries as required by Resolution 11/04.

Coverage was reported as total enumeration
