CPC: South Africa	Responses/clarifications
• Has not provided the all mandatory information for the list of active vessels in 2019, mandatory information missing; IOTC No, Name & address of owner, operator and/or charterer, as required by Resolution 10/08.	Updated information submitted on 17 March 2022.
• Has not implemented the requirement on inspection of At least 5% inspection of LAN/TRX, as required by Resolution 16/11.	There were 415 foreign (fishing and carrier/reefer) vessels that entered South Africa's ports in 2019, from the Atlantic, Southern and Indian Oceans. Of these, South Africa inspected 52 that were coming from the IOTC. As such, it is evidently clear that South Africa achieved the minimum of 5% requirement. It should be noted that the PIRs for the inspected vessels were uploaded on the AREP system.
• Has not implemented the Prohibition from intentionally fishing within 1 nautical mile of or interacting with data buoy, as required by Resolution 19/04.	South Africa prohibits any fishing using data buoys. This has been legislated since 2021.
• Has not provided the all mandatory information for the list authorized vessels 24 metres in length overall or more, mandatory information missing: Beneficial owner, Company, Photographes, as required by Resolution 19/04.	The list was updated on 3 July 2019.
• Has not provided the all mandatory information for the Authorized vessels (less than 24m, operating in waters outside EEZ of the flag state), mandatory information missing; Beneficial owner, Company, Photographes, as required by Resolution 19/04.	South Africa did not have vessels less than 24m operating outside of its EEZ during this particular period.
• Has not reported the BET 1st Semester report at IOTC Standard, as required by Resolution 01/06.	Sent to the IOTC Secretariat on 2020/09/01
• Has not reported the BET 2nd Semester report at IOTC Standard, as required by Resolution 01/06.	Sent to the IOTC Secretariat on 2020/09/01
• Has not reported the BET annual report at IOTC Standard, as required by Resolution 01/06.	Sent to the IOTC Secretariat on 2020/09/01
