14. ADOPTION OF THE REPORT OF THE 26th SESSION OF THE COMMISSION

**From (IOTC-2019-S23-R): In 2019 the Commission noted the statement made by the Republic of Mauritius requesting the inclusion of an item on the Agenda of the meeting relating to the termination of the United Kingdom(BIOT)'s membership of the Commission as a coastal State following the adoption of the UNGA resolution 73/295 on May 22, 2019. The Chair concluded that this issue was a global one. The Chair also noted that the Commission as a specialised institution of the UN would need to abide by the Resolution of the UN General Assembly but given that the delegates present may not have had proper guidance from their capitals, the Chair requested Mauritius to allow us to take note of the issue but to put the issue of the termination of United Kingdom(BIOT)'s membership at the IOTC as a coastal State as an item on the agenda for the next session of the Commission. The matter was deferred in 2020 and 2021 due to the Commission meetings being held in a limited format.*
