Question	Relevant provisions in the new ICCAT Convention
What is the reason for your objection?	Article IX
	 3. (c) A Member of the Commission presenting an objection in accordance with sub-paragraph (a) above shall provide to the Commission in writing, at the time of presenting its objection, the reason for its objection, which shall be based on one or more of the following grounds: (i) the recommendation is inconsistent with this Convention or other relevant rules of international law; (ii) the recommendation unjustifiably discriminates in form or in fact against the objecting Member of the Commission; (iii) the Member of the Commission cannot practicably comply with the measure because it has adopted a different approach to conservation and sustainable management or because it does not have the technical capabilities to implement the recommendation; or (iv) security constraints as a result of which the objecting Member of the Commission is not in a position to implement or comply with the measure.
Do you have any fisheries development plan and capacity management plan for yellowfin tuna fisheries?	
Upon your objection to Res. 21/01, have you implemented any alternative conservation and management measures for yellowfin tuna?	3.(d) Each Member of the Commission that presents an objection pursuant to this Article shall also provide to the Commission, to the extent practicable, a description of any alternative conservation and management measures, which shall be at least equally effective as the measure to which it is objecting.
