## ENTRY INTO EFFECT OF THE CONSERVATION AND MANAGEMENT MEASURES ADOPTED BY THE IOTC AT ITS 26<sup>TH</sup> SESSION

Pursuant to Article IX.4 of the IOTC Agreement, the following Conservation and Management Measures, adopted by the Commission at its 26<sup>th</sup> Session entered into effect on Tuesday 22 September 2022:

<u>Resolution 22/01</u> On climate change as it relates to the Indian Ocean Tuna Commission.

<u>Resolution 22/02</u> On establishing a programme for transhipment by large-scale fishing vessels.

Resolution 22/03 On a Management Procedure for bigeye tuna in the IOTC area of competence.

Resolution 22/04 On a Regional Observer Scheme.
