National report not provided in time for Scientific Committee meeting as required by SC04	In the past, Tanzania has used old versions of the template. Tanzania will use the new template in 2022. Data for artisanal fisheries have been aggregated; Tanzania has now ensured collaboration between different institutions and harmonisation of the databases to ensure disaggregation.
• Catch & effort data not provided for all coastal fisheries as required by Resolution 15/02	Tanzania could not provide for all coastal fisheries; henceforth, Tanzania is in a position to provide information for all coastal fisheries.
• Catch & effort data not provided to IOTC standard for longline fisheries as required by Resolution 15/02	Tanzania had errors in the grid square code. It is now briefed on the grids for coastal and longline (5 degrees) and surface purse seiners (1 degree) and shall provide the coordinates in form 3CE.
• Size frequency data not provided to IOTC standard for coastal fisheries as required by Resolution 15/02	Tanzania had aggregated for all coastal gear; also grid size code should have been 5, not 1 for 1°x1° No new SF data for coastal fisheries.
• Nominal catch data for sharks not provided to IOTC standard as required by Resolution 15/02	It was aggregated for all fisheries. Tanzania has conducted inhouse training on disaggregation and reports submitted by the 30 June deadline.
• Catch & effort data for sharks not provided to IOTC standard as required by Resolution 15/02	It was aggregated as sharks <i>nei</i> . Tanzania has conducted inhouse training on disaggregation and reports submitted by 30 June deadline.
• Size frequency data for sharks not provided for all fisheries as required by Resolution 15/02	It was only available for coastal fisheries and for foreign LL. Tanzania has conducted in-house training on disaggregation and reports submitted by 30 June deadline.
• Report on progress on implementation not received as required by Resolution 12/04	Tanzania had submitted an NPOA 2020-25 but had omitted to submit the progress report. Will do so for the deadline of the Implementation Report in 2023.
• Has not provided information on actions taken domestically to monitor catches of Blue Shark as required by Resolution 18/02	More details shall be provided on monitoring the catches of blue shark in the National Scientific Report and reference made to paragraphs in Table 9.
• Mandatory information missing on foreign vessels as required by Resolution 14/05	Mandatory information on the form will be completed and care taken with regards to the licenses denied option.
• Nominal catch for longline fisheries not provided to IOTC standard as required by Resolution 15/02	Was combined with foreign vessel catch. National and foreign vessel catches shall be disaggregated.
• Has not reported on the seabird mitigation of measures as required by Resolution 12/06	It was reported as not applicable but had LL on RAV. Tanzania still has a longline on the RAV so shall indicate the legal mitigation measures according to the CQ template.
