3. ARRIVAL AND ENTRY FORMALITIES (VISA)

Travelers are required to:

- Hold a Passport or any other recognized travel document, which is valid beyond the intended period of stay.
- Hold a valid return passage ticket to travel back to his/her country of origin or residence.
- Be eligible to re-enter his/her country of origin or residence.
- Have adequate funds to meet the cost of his/her stay.
- Have a confirmed hotel booking or sponsorship for accommodation.

- should be in possession of an invitation letter referencing the meeting they are attending.
- should fill in the online "Mauritius All-In-One Travel Digital Form" at most Seventy-Two (72) hrs prior to undertake travel to Mauritius. This form is available on <https://safemauritius.govmu.org>
- Should you need to apply for visa, please do so well in advance, at least fifteen(15) days before travelling

4. HEALTH ENTRY AND STAY CONDITIONS FOR TRAVELLERS

There is no imminent health risk in Mauritius.

- COVID-19 remains a risk in Mauritius.
- Insect-borne diseases include dengue, malaria and chikungunya. The risk of malaria is low. Ensure your accommodation is insect-proof. Use insect repellent. Carry your yellow fever vaccination certificate if you're coming from a country where yellow fever is present.
- Foodborne, waterborne and other infectious diseases can include gastroenteritis and hepatitis. Drink only boiled or bottled water. Avoid raw or undercooked food.
- The standard of public medical facilities varies. Most travellers go to private doctors or clinics. If you're seriously ill or injured, you may need medical evacuation. Ensure your travel insurance covers this.
