THE IOTC IUU VESSELS LIST — UPDATE OF 25 MAY 2023

In accordance with Paragraph 30 of IOTC Resolution 18/03 *On establishing a list of vessels presumed to have carried out illegal, unreported and unregulated fishing in the IOTC Area*, I wish to inform CPCs that I have received the attached message from the Head of Delegation of the European Union.

Consequently, the IOTC Secretariat has verified this information through consultations with the ICCAT Secretariat, which has confirmed that the IUU records for the vessel SAGE and CHIA HAO No. 66 have been consolidated into only one record, through their IUU listing and review process.

Therefore, I also wish to inform CPCs that the IOTC IUU Vessels List has subsequently been updated, on 25 May 2023, and re-published in the IOTC website. The IUU Vessels List can be downloaded from the following link [Click Here](#).
