- Your National Legislation in Word or PDF format: Copies of laws, regulations and administrative instructions in force,
 - For upload and completion of the section LEGAL OBLIGATION of e-MARIS requirements.
- Practise VMS requirement completion:
 - REQ 4.1 VMS adopted. Participants of each country must bring the legislation having provision for the adoption of VMS,
 - REQ 4.2 VMS report Participants of each country must bring the VMS report template completed,
 - REQ 4.3 VMS plan Participants of each country must bring the VMS plan completed if the coverage is still below 50% coverage.
- Practise 2022 Foreign vessels landing requirement completion:
 - REQ 11.1 Foreign vessels landing. Participants of each country must bring the required data and the template report completed.

<u>INFORMATION REQUIRED: LIST OF FOREIGN FISHING VESSELS</u> <u>LANDING IN PORTS</u>

"Each CPC shall submit electronically to the IOTC Executive Secretary by 1 July of each year, the list of foreign fishing vessels which have landed in their ports tuna and tuna-like species caught in the IOTC area in the preceding year. This information shall detail the catch composition by weight and species landed."

Practise - requirement completion:

Select at least two other e-MARIS requirements you wish to complete during the training. It is required that you bring with you the relevant legislations in force and the data/information related to those requirements for completion during the training.

Note: please bring the real, actual data that your country would be submitting to the IOTC Secretariat, as we will do real submissions in e-MARIS, which will be assessed for your Compliance Report.

For e-RAV

- One laptop computer by country, with WiFi connectivity;
- For upload, please bring one of your recent Vessel data submission files, or the IOTC Secretariat can provide them.

Note: for the RAV training, we will NOT be doing real submissions, as the application will only enter production at a later stage. This will only be an advance training exercise.
