Review the possible infractions detected under the Regional Observer Programme in 2023

PREPARED BY: IOTC SECRETARIAT¹, 31 JANUARY 2024

PURPOSE

To provide participants at the Working Party on the Implementation of Conservation and Management Measures (WPICMM) with the list of possible infractions, against IOTC Conservation and Management Measures (CMMs), detected under the Regional Observer Programme (ROP) in 2023 and as recorded by observers deployed under the at-sea transhipment programme.

BACKGROUND

The component 10, sub-component 10.1, of the work Plan of the WPICMM comprise the following activities:

10	Monitor the development of, and recommend actions for the list of Large Scale Tuna Longline Vessels (LSTLVs)/carrier vessels presumed to have committed infractions of IOTC CMMs, as recorded by observers deployed under the at-sea transhipment programme
10.1	List of possible infractions under the ROP
10.1.1	Review of the evidence to be presented on vessels presumed to have committed the infractions
10.1.2	Request for further evidence from the CPCs on the list of vessels presumed to have committed infractions
10.1.3	Recommend actions for the CoC on the list of vessels presumed to have committed infractions
10.1.4	Monitor the development of recommended actions on the vessels that have committed infractions
10.1.5	Recommend that the list of possible infraction under the ROP is presented to the WPICMM

DISCUSSION

The work plan of the WPICMM, on component 10 "Monitor the development of, and recommend actions for the list of Large Scale Tuna Longline Vessels (LSTLVs)/carrier vessels presumed to have committed infractions of IOTC CMMs, as recorded by observers deployed under the at-sea transhipment programme", and more specifically, on Subcomponent 10.1, makes provision for CPCs to review the list of possible infractions detected under the ROP and recommend actions for the Compliance Committee (CoC) on the list of vessels presumed to have committed infractions (Activity 10.1.3).

In line with the above, the <u>Sixteenth Session of the Compliance Committee (CoC16)</u> made the following recommendation:

<u>IOTC-2019-CoC16-R</u> Paragraph 31: Notwithstanding the timing of the WPICMM meeting and the deadline for responses, the CoC **RECOMMENDED** that the responses to the possible infractions be analyse by the IOTC Secretariat.

In view of the above recommendation the IOTC Secretariat notified the list of possible infractions reported up to the 31st December 2023 (Annex I), in order to receive the results of the investigations by 15th January 2024, from the concerned fleets.

In line with the requirement of IOTC Resolution 23/05 *On establishing a programme for transhipment by large-scale fishing vessels*, this document provides a summary of the observed possible infractions against IOTC Resolutions by Large Scale Tuna Longline Vessels (LSTLVs) and carrier vessels, as recorded by observers deployed under the Programme during 2023.

Paragraph 31.The IOTC Secretariat shall, when providing CPCs with copies of all raw data, summaries and reports in accordance with paragraph 10 of Annex IV to this Resolution, also indicate evidence indicating possible violation of IOTC CMMs by LSTLVs/carrier vessels flagged to that CPC. Upon receiving such evidence, each CPC shall investigate the cases and report the results of the investigation back to the IOTC Secretariat three months prior to the annual Session of the IOTC Compliance Committee. The IOTC Secretariat shall circulate among CPCs the list of names and flags of the LSTLVs/Carrier vessels that were involved in such possible violations as well as the response of the flag CPCs 80 days prior to the annual Session of the IOTC Compliance Committee.

The summary of possible infractions is presented in Table 1, sorted by fleet across four distinct categories: Possible infractions relating to authorisation to fish (ATF), Possible infractions relating to Vessel Monitoring System (VMS), Possible infractions relating to fishing logbooks, and Possible infractions relating to marking of fishing vessels. Detailed information on these possible infractions is available in Annex I. The observations made by observers are in fulfilment of their assigned tasks, as specified in Resolution 23/05.

- 1. Annex IV, Paragraph 5. The observer tasks shall be as follows:
 - a) On the fishing vessel intending to tranship to the carrier vessel and before the transhipment takes place, the observer shall:
 - i. check the validity of the fishing vessel's authorisation or licence to fish tuna and tuna-like species and sharks in the IOTC area of competence;
 - ii. check and note the total quantity of catch on board, and the quantity to be transferred to the carrier vessel;
 - iii. check that the VMS is functioning and examine the logbook;
 - iv. verify whether any of the catch on board resulted from transfers from other vessels, and check documentation on such transfers;
 - v. in the case of an indication that there are any violations involving the fishing vessel, immediately report the violations to the carrier vessel's master,
 - vi. report the results of these duties on the fishing vessel in the observers report.

In all, up to the 31st December 2023, a total of 127² possible infractions were recorded (2022: 148; 2021: 10; 2020: 59), of which:

- 26 related to ATF (2022: 13; 2021: 3; 2020: 20),
- 11 related to VMS (2022: 3; 2021: 0; 2020: 0),
- 38 related to fishing logbook (2022: 50; 2021: 3; 2020: 20),
- 52 related to marking of vessels (2022: 81; 2021: 4; 2020: 19),

These were communicated to the concerned fleets participating in the Programme, as and when the concerned deployment reports were approved by the IOTC Secretariat.

Of the total possible infractions notified, 127 responses were received from the relevant fleets (Table 1). Five fleets, China, Japan, Malaysia, Seychelles and Taiwan, Province of China submitted their responses by the deadline of 15th January 2024. Notably, one fleet, Mauritius, has provided some of its responses to the reported possible infractions after the deadline. The responses are provided in paper IOTC-2024-WPICMM07-04 Add2.

² Two possible infractions related to southern bluefin tuna were observed in vessels flagged to the Republic of Korea and Taiwan, China. Both instances of possible infractions were related to non-compliance of CCSBT regulations and have been redirected for the consideration of CCSBT's Compliance Committee.
