CONSERVATION AND MANAGEMENT MEASURES ADOPTED BY THE IOTC AT ITS 28TH ANNUAL SESSION

I have the honour to transmit to you the texts of the following 11 Conservation and Management Measures adopted by the Commission at its 28th Session which was held in Thailand from 13 to 17 May 2024.

Resolution 24-01 On climate change as it relates to the Indian Ocean Tuna Commission [download here].

Resolution 24-02 On management of drifting fish aggregating devices (FADS) in the IOTC area of competence [download here].

Resolution 24-03 On establishment of a list of vessels presumed to have carried out illegal, unreported and unregulated fishing in the IOTC area of competence [download here].
