ENTRY INTO EFFECT OF RESOLUTION 2023-07 ADOPTED BY THE IOTC AT ITS 27TH SESSION

The following Conservation and Management Measure, adopted by the Commission at its 27th Session in 2023, entered into force on Monday 1 July 2024:

Resolution 23-07 On reducing the incidental bycatch of seabirds in longline fisheries.

This is consistent with Paragraphs 11 and 12 of the CMM which state:

- 11. This Resolution shall enter into force on 1 July 2024.
- 12. As of 1 July 2024, the Resolution 12/06 On reducing incidental bycatch of seabirds in longline fisheries is superseded by this Resolution.
