Treaty Ceremony during the Forty-fifth Session of the FAO Conference

The Director-General of the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (FAO), acting in his capacity as Depositary of multilateral treaties approved by the Conference or the Council under Article XIV of the FAO Constitution ("Article XIV Treaties"), communicates the following:

A Treaty Ceremony will be held at FAO headquarters during the Forty-fifth Session of the FAO Conference, to be convened in Rome, Italy, from 26 June to 2 July 2027.

At the Treaty Ceremony, Members may deposit instruments of ratification, accession, acceptance, approval or adherence, in person, with the Director-General, in relation to the Article XIV Treaties.

Members may recall that the Article XIV Treaties are multilateral agreements adopted by the Members concerning questions relating to food and agriculture, and that they constitute an important component of FAO's normative framework.

The date and time of the Treaty Ceremony will be communicated to Members in due course.
